

Youth Hunting Training Course

Are you a youth from 12-17, who would like to learn traditional hunting practices in an authentic learning environment?



The Indigenous Education Coalition will be hosting a Hunting training course for youth at the Nmaachihna: Indigenous Enviro-education Centre in Delaware Nation (Moraviantown).

The courses will be run from Friday to Sunday with a feast culminating with family of the youth to share in the animals they hunted.

The dates for the course are:

January 27-29

February 3-5

This course will teach the youth:

- Safe gun handling and hunting practices
- How to hunt different animals such as squirrel, rabbit and deer.
- How to properly clean and butcher different animals
- How to use all of the different parts of the animals in cultural practices
- The youth will gain an appreciation for traditional hunting practices as well as the traditional teachings associated with hunting
- The youth will be shown and taught traditional cooking practices
- The youth will have the experience of a life time as they will be staying in traditional wigwams!
